^The USP Math and Inference Requirements can be satisfied with 1 calculus course. If at any point you complete a calculus course, future courses marked with a ^ may be replaced with electives.

»Incoming students do not have to enroll in ENG 104 if they have any of the following: 1) An ACT English score of 32 or higher; 2) an SAT Verbal score of 700 or higher; 3) or a score of 4 or 5 on the English Language AP exam. In these situations, the student should replace ENG 104 with electives.

»Students who have taken at least 2 **years** of a language in high school can complete the A&S Foreign Language Requirement with 3 college semesters of a *different* language. Students choosing this option should replace the 4th semester of language with electives. Also note that if you take a foreign language placement exam, you may be exempt from 1 or more of the beginning semesters of that language. In this case, replace the by-passed language courses with electives.

+ 6 hours of 'free' electives - that do not count toward any other requirement - must be taken. Additional electives may be required to reach the required minimum of 120 hours. Consider pursuing a 2nd major or minor with these elective hours.
