»Incoming students do not have to enroll in ENG 104 if they have any of the following: 1) An ACT English score of 32 or higher; 2) An SAT Verbal score of 700 or higher; 3) Or a score of 4 or 5 on the English Language AP exam. The student should replace ENG 104 with electives. ENG 104 must be taken any time in the first year of study at UK.

»Students who took two **years** of a language in high school can complete the A&S foreign language requirement with three college semesters of a **different** language. Students choosing this option should replace the fourth semester of language with an elective. Taking a foreign language placement exam, may exempt you from one or more semesters of that language. Replace by-passed language courses with electives. Any language sequence may be taken.

*To be discussed with your academic advisor. Each semester GWS provides a list of approved non-GWS elective courses.

+ 6 hours of 'free' electives - that do not count toward any other requirement - must be taken. Additional electives may be required to reach the required minimum of 120 hours. Consider pursuing a 2nd major or minor with these elective hours.
