About the University of Kentucky

The University of Kentucky is home to more than 70 nationally ranked programs, including more than 25 programs in the top 20. This major public research university consistently ranks among the top institutions for quality and value in the U.S. In addition, the University of Kentucky's diverse student population represents 117 countries, every state in the US, and every county in Kentucky.

What is 3+2 Program?

After completing three years of Junior College, students will transfer to the University of Kentucky and continue their study in order to get their bachelor's degree. Upon successful completion of all degree requirements of University of Kentucky, a Bachelor of Arts or a Bachelor of Science degree will be awarded from the University of Kentucky.

3+2 Programs in the College of Arts & Sciences

The University of Kentucky offers 3+2 programs in all majors housed in the College of Arts & Sciences, however the following majors are ideally suited for 3+2 programs:

How will the 3+2 Program Benefit Me?

- Students receive the advantage of studying abroad for two years while paying their home institution's tuition during the first three years.
- Students will take approved courses at their home institution allowing simple credit transfers.
- 3+2 program allows students to transfer to the University of Kentucky's campus in their third year, thereby saving a portion of the cost of a U.S. Undergraduate Degree.
- Many students have the opportunity to conduct research during their first year attending the University of Kentucky.
- The opportunity to be part of a program that offers an undergraduate degree in a different country enhances employability prospects and career paths.
- Studying in another country gives you the opportunity to experience different styles in education and is a great way to experience and understand the people, its traditions, and its culture.
- Multinational companies are interested in hiring multilingual students who have studied in both countries and understand the similarities and differences in regulatory and cultural extents.

What Kind of Support can I Expect?

- The University of Kentucky has an experienced Chinese alumnus who will personally assist all students (at no charge) with the application process and provide personal guidance to all students.
- Professional advisors will be assigned to all students to help determine degree requirements and assist with course selection and scheduling.
- The College of Arts & Sciences has a partnership with The Center for English as a Second Language. Students who wish to enhance their English speaking the reading abilities have the opportunity to take CESL-English intensive courses to better their knowledge of the language.
- The International Center has partnerships with numerous Chinese Universities. This office provides support to Chinese students during their time at in Kentucky and beyond.
- The Confucius Institute at the University of Kentucky is among the most established in the United States.
- The University of Kentucky is in the process of building an International Village on campus. Scheduled to open in Fall 2017, the International Village will provide a place for American and foreign students to share ideas, experiences and cultures.

Scholarship Opportunities

- All students participating in the 3+2 program with an Arts & Sciences major will be awarded the Arts & Sciences International Excellence Scholarship in the guaranteed amount of \$1,000 during their first year.
- All 3+2 students are eligible for consideration for the University of Kentucky transfer student scholarship. The deadline for receipt of admission application, transcript, and scholarship application is normally in early June. Contact us for the exact deadline.

There is only one application for all the scholarships and you are placed in the candidate pool for any scholarship you qualify for.

What are the Requirements for the 3+2 Program?

- Complete the UK International Student Application.
- Achieve a minimum 2.0 Cumulative Grade Point Average for all coursework completed at your home institution as determined by the UK Office of Admissions.
- Demonstrate English language proficiency by earning a TOEFL 71 (internet-based) or IELTS 6.0.
 - Students who meet all other standard admissions requirements but to not meet English proficiency standards will receive a second conditional admission and be allowed to enroll in the UK Center for English as a Second Language (CESL), on a non-credit basis and according to the CESL fee structure.
- Be certified to be in good standing as successfully completing the degree program curriculum.
- Provide proof of funding.

3+2 项目介绍

- 学生前三年在中国学习，只需支付中国大学的学习费用，完成学习后，再通过两年时间便可完成优质的海外本科学习。
- 学生在中国修完的认证课程可以顺利的在肯塔基完成学分转换。
- 3 + 2 项目允许学生将前三年的中国大学学分转到肯塔基大学，从而节省了美国本科学习的费用。
- 许多学生在他们来肯塔基大学的第一年就有机会参加学校的研究项目。
- 拥有海外的本科学历，有利于拓宽就业前景并为职业发展铺平道路。

- 每位学生将会被分配专业的学术顾问，他们会帮助学生确定学位要求，所修课程，并帮助注册所有必修的课程。
- 肯塔基大学孔子学院是全美最优秀的孔子学院之一。
- 文理学院与语言中心的合作关系，为想要提高英语口语和阅读能力的学生提供了参加英语强化课程的机会，来提高语言能力。
- 肯塔基大学正在投入建设“国际村”项目，并且将会在2017年开放。这将为美国同学和国际学生提供一个分享创意、经验和文化的平台。

什么是3+2项目的申请要求？

- 完成肯塔基大学国际学生的申请。
- 国内学习阶段的平均绩点在2.0以上，并以肯塔基大学招生办的计算为准。
- TOEFL成绩要求71分，或者IELTS成绩要求6.0。
 - 符合肯塔基大学学术要求，但没有达到肯塔基大学语言要求的同学，将会收到有条件录取通知书，并可通过参加语言中心的无学分语言课程以达到语言要求。
- 成功完成国内阶段的学位课程。
- 提供资金证明。
