- □ Two letters of recommendation from University of Kentucky <u>faculty members</u> (other than the professor supervising independent work, if applicable) are required.
- Please note that if you are not participating in Independent Study 395 during your Winter Travel, EA Insurance MUST be purchased and you must provide proof of purchase before scholarship money is received.
