PLEASE NOTE: The bankruptcy period includes academic work earned at UK prior to readmission. GPA is the calculation of grade point average since readmission.

Senate Rule 5.4.1.4

- A. Undergraduate students who have been readmitted through the usual channels after an interruption of two or more years, and who have completed 12 hours with a grade point standing of 2.0 or better after readmission, may choose to have none of their previous University of Kentucky course work counted toward graduation and toward the computation of their grade point standing.
- B. The 12-hour requirement of this rule must be met by enrolling in courses offered by the University of Kentucky. The courses must be taken after the student has been readmitted. In calculating the 2.0 GPA, a student must have taken all of the 12 hours necessary to apply for bankruptcy for a letter grade.
- C. Part-time as well as full-time students can take advantage of the academic bankruptcy rule. Students need not have been originally suspended from the University to qualify for this option.
- D. A student who has completed at least 12 hours of work with a GPA of 2.0 or better would be eligible for academic bankruptcy even if she/he received an E in one or more of the courses.
- E. If a student has completed a degree and re-enrolls, they may not apply the academic bankruptcy rule to courses taken for the awarded degree.
