- * To be discussed with your academic advisor. 18 hours of courses with a CLA prefix are required and 12 hours of approved electives outside of CLA are required. Students are required to complete 39 hours of 300-level or higher courses for the College of Arts and Sciences.
- 6 hours of 'free' electives that do not count toward any other requirement must be taken. Additional electives may be required to reach the required minimum of 120 hours. Consider pursuing a 2nd major or minor.
