- ∞ Students should complete an Academic Approval form and have it reviewed by the International Studies Director prior to departure.
- **Race and Ethnicity Requirement:** The College requires its students to complete an approved race and ethnicity (R&E) course that will address the changing meanings of race and ethnicity across time and space. Students may double-dip courses to satisfy the R&E requirement with any other requirement.
