If the student has been accepted into the University Honors Program, the student is required to take WRD 112 to fulfill CC1 and CC2.

- ◇ 6 hours of 'free' electives - that do not count toward any other requirement - must be taken. Additional electives may be required to reach the required minimum of 120 hours. Consider pursuing a 2nd major or minor.

Students may double-dip courses to satisfy the R&E requirement with any other requirement.
