The International Village is one of 15 Living Learning Programs (LLPs) on University of Kentucky's campus. First-year international students join American students to form a community where the focus is on learning about the world from and with each other, as well as engaging with University of Kentucky faculty.

The International Village is located in Blazer Hall. Room assignments pair students from differing backgrounds, and dedicated programming offers opportunities to explore others' cultures and develop international friendships. Through cultural and recreational programming as well as through connected coursework, students will have regular interactions with faculty, peer mentors, and staff dedicated to supporting their academic success at the University of Kentucky.

WHY JOIN THE INTERNATIONAL VILLAGE?

- Meet other students who are interested in learning more about our global society.
- Live with an American student who is excited about having an international student roommate.
- Live in a new residence hall that remains open during all of the university breaks (Thanksgiving, winter and spring).
