

Major core requirements: SOC 302, SOC 303 (or PSY 216), SOC 304. (SOC 302 fulfills the UK GCCR requirement.) Other requirements: Choose at least 18 hours of 300+ level Sociology courses, at least 6 hours of which must be at the 400+ level.

Note: For a 2 year plan, we assume that the student will arrive with most of the UK Core and A&S college requirements complete. Courses are available within the major that fulfill some UK Core requirements, such as SOC 303 (UKC SIR). It is possible that students declaring the degree as juniors may already have completed some of the required hours "outside the major" or even some of the 100 or 200 level premajor courses. If students have not completed the A&S college foreign language requirement, then those courses will need to be added to the plan above.
