*The courses that double count are GER Major Core Electives and/or simply additional elective hours students take to reach 120 hours.

Students complete 12 hours of MA work senior year: GER 507, GER 5---, GER 5---, and GER 5---. The precise numbering will clearly depend on offerings and year. German Studies offers most graduate courses as 500/600 or 500/700 splits, at least 2 each semester to facilitate the 4+1 for USP students.

**Note: GER 507 is offered each fall and should be taken by USP students, unless otherwise advised. Additional 500-level courses will rotate, with 2 in addition to 507 available in the fall and 3 available in the spring.

With 12 hours at the 500-level completed during the senior year, the M.A. in German Studies can be completed in 1 additional year of study. Student must complete an additional 18 hours, 15 hours of which need to be above the 500-level according to German Studies M.A. requirements.
